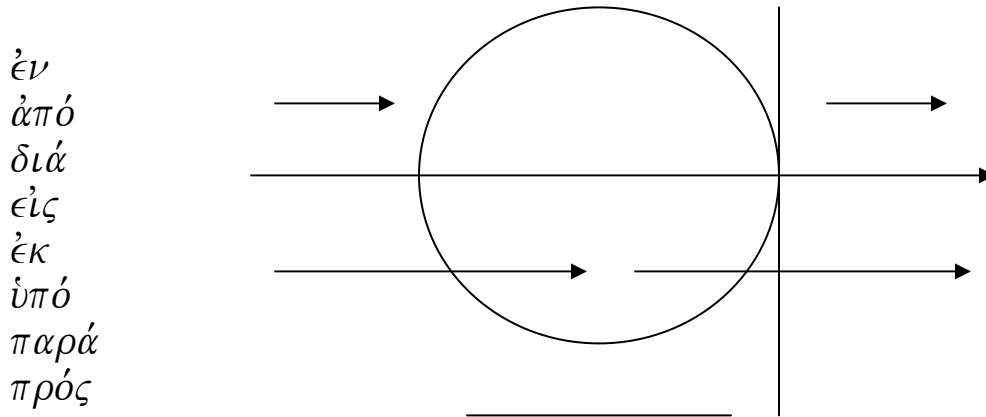


Preposition Chart:
